

 Point 1
 Understanding What It Means to Be a Missionary

What is a Missionary?: Typically in the church we were taught to believe that missionaries were ladies who wore white suits and were a part of the missionary circle. Also, typically we did not think men were missionaries.

However, not so in the early church. We see in this text that the Church sent out missionaries and they were not ladies in white suits.
