

I. The Holy Spirit Indwells in a Believer

Along the journey you will need the aid and assistance of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the indwelling presence of Christ in a believer's life: Ephesians 3:14-19

We are to be filled with fruit of the Spirit: Galatians 5:22-23:





II. To be Filled with the Spirit

Read Ephesians 5:18

Believers are to be filled with the Spirit, which means to be controlled by the Spirit.

- 1. To be filled with the Holy Spirit is the activity (Acts 4:8) of Jesus Christ in the life of a believer. It is when Christ gets into our total being and we move and respond to voice of Christ.
 - a. The indwelling person of Christ is the basic characteristic of a Christian
 - b. Philippians 2:13- Christ moves, works, and proves Himself in our hearts of those who serve Him.
- 2. The Spirit Indwells Among Sinning Christians
 - a. Paul reminded Christians that the Spirit indwells, I Cor. 3:16, 6:19. It must be noted that the Spirit does not come and go, the Spirit is not based on a feeling, it is based on truth.
 - b. Sin is not strong enough to drive the Spirit away.

QUESTION: What do people mean when they say, I am not good enough to serve God, or not good enough to attend church?

II. The Conditions for Being Spirit-Filled

Spirit-filling means that the Spirit has control in a believer's life. It means that the believer is yielding and being obedient to the Spirit. Thus, obedience is the condition for the filling.

- A. One must have a Dedicated Life, Romans 12:1-2
 - a. One must present their life.
 - b. There must be separation, as not to be conformed to the world
 - c. There must be continual transformation.
- B. One Must live an Undefeated Life
 - a. The believer must be willing to admit to sin. Because sin goes against God's standard of holiness, I Peter 1:15-16.
 - b. Know that certain sins grieve the Holy Spirit, ie useless speech, bitterness, anger, wrath, evil speaking, Ephesians 4:29-31.
- C. One Must Live a Dependent Life, Gal. 5:16
 - a. Abide by God's Standard,
 - i. Love, John 13:34
 - ii. Pray without ceasing, I Thes. 5:17
 - b. Must be dependent because Satan is strong, I Peter 5:8

III. The Consequences of Being Filled

- A. Christlike Character, Gal. 5:22-23, to be Spirit filled is not to obey the lust of the flesh, but produce the fruit of the Spirit.
- B. Worship and Praise, Eph, 5:18-20. Praise God through outward expression speaking to one another in hymns and spiritual songs. Second, inner expression of praise by singing and making melody in your heart.
- C. Submissiveness, Eph 5:21, living a life of submission in various relationships.
- D. Service, John 7:37-39
