II. Appointment for Healing

Have you been meeting with Jesus, specifically praying for healing over your body, ie from your sicknesses, diseases, and ailments.

Divine Healing – is complete healing and curing from the ailments that plague our bodies. Mark 1:22-25 – Jesus cast out unclean spirits.

Mark 2:4-10 – Cleansing of sins

QUESTION: Have you earnestly and sincerely prayed and asked for forgiveness for the sins that maybe causing illness.

Divine Healing – Transfer of Jesus’ energy to the afflicted place in your body

Action Steps for Divine Healing – Mark 5:35-43

1. Do you accept your condition as final? Vs. 35
2. Are you fearful about changing your condition vs. 36
3. Have you asked for Divine prayer warriors vs. 38
4. What is the opposite scenario of your current situation? Vs. 39
5. Who do you need to remove from your life, that maybe hindering your healing? vs. 40

Disciples pursue times to show kindness – Mark3:3-5

Disciples are caring people and willing to meet a need – Mark 6:36-42
